Under the direction of the Subject Leader

Under the direction of the appropriate progress manager:

- to be a member of a pastoral team as allocated and to support the activities of the Year;
- to be a form tutor of an assigned form (whether permanently or as required) and to carry out related duties in accordance with the generic job description of a form tutor.

- to participate in appropriate meetings with colleagues, parents and others, relative to the above duties.
