The language content of the performance will be specifically tailored to the pupils' experience and knowledge of French so far.

What makes The Flying Theatre Company unique?

Performances are highly original, visually entertaining and leave a lasting impression on the audience. They are very physical and draw on many skills to enable the audience to enjoy the experience.

Performances are built on a fusion of improvisational and popular theatre traditions including:

- *Comedy: scripts are tailored to the comedy style of The Flying Theatre Company making every production unique and accessible.*
- *Variety: music, live music, singing, and playing of instruments, illusions and special effects, mime, stage fighting, magic.*
- *Circus skills: juggling, balancing – and other feats of daring-do!*
