Dear Parent/Guardian, Annwyl Riant/Warcheidwad

The GCSE examination in Geography requires all pupils to complete Geographical Enquiry worth 20% of the final grade.

It has been decided this year that pupils will complete a study on the impacts of tourism in Snowdonia National Park and a Rivers study along the River Clywedog in Wrexham. There is a proposed fieldtrip to Betws-y-Coed. This will give the students the chance to collect primary data in a human and physical geography setting and reinforce the work they have completed in Year 10. There will also be a local trip in October, the details of which will be finalised at a later date.

Location: Betws-y-Coed, Conwy

Date: Wednesday 19th September 2018

Time: 9.00am – 4.30pm (approx.)

Parental Contribution: £13.00

Activity: Pupils carry out questionnaires, surveys and mapping. Non uniform, pupils will require a warm waterproof jacket, warm clothing, shoes suitable for walking.

Lunch: Packed lunch required.

Other: Pens, Pencils, Rubber, Camera (optional)

We will have to ask for parental contribution of £13.00 to cover transport costs. This is based on all pupils completing the fieldwork. Without sufficient funds the fieldtrip cannot go ahead. The pupils require their own transport home from school due to the late finish. The Parental Consent form and payment must be completed and returned to the School Shop between 08.30 – 09.10am, by Wednesday 12th September. Cheques should be made payable to Ysgol Clywedog.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal and wishes to receive a free packed lunch for the trip, please ensure your child informs Miss Berry, at least one week before the trip leaves.

It is expected that all pupils will behave in a mature and sensible manner showing respect for local people and their environment. I would be grateful if you would discuss this with your son/daughter before the trip.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents/guardian that the GCSE Unit 3 Geography Exam, is due to take place during the week beginning 12th November 2018. This is a GCSE examination and it will account for 20% of the final qualification. It is therefore essential that your child attends both of these trips in order to collect the necessary data.
